



The PS900 offers Optical and Image Mark Reading through a seamless integration of these two technologies primarily used for applications combining category data with image.

## Course content

The course content will vary depending on the individual requirements and may include:

- routine maintenance, fault finding and repair of the DRS PhotoScribe® Series of Image Mark Readers
- routine maintenance, fault finding and repair of the DRS CD Series of Optical Mark Readers
- calibration, setup and testing of the above
- replacing or upgrading the firmware for the above.

The distributor training may also, by prior arrangement, include other modules such as SOSKit and SOSKit Developer training.

## Pre-requisites

Candidates should be English speaking and be familiar with:

- the use of Microsoft Windows NT, Windows 2000, Windows XP or a similar environment
- PC ISA/PCI architecture
- the operation and maintenance of electro-mechanical devices
- the theory and practice of networking
- some knowledge of OMR and Imaging theory would be useful but not essential.
